

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must live in a single-family residence within the Tualatin Valley Water District, including a house, condominium, duplex/multiplex or manufactured home with a single or master meter. **Note:** Customers in the Southwood Park Water District, Valley View Water District and apartment owners currently **DO NOT** qualify for rebate(s).
- The applicant must have a current TVWD water account in good standing. If the applicant does not have a TVWD water account, the applicant must be the owner of the master metered residence within the District as verified by TVWD.
- Applications must be received within 90 days of purchase date and include a copy of the proof of purchase in the form of a sales receipt or purchase invoice that specifies the product and date.
- Pre-existing products and services **are not** eligible.
- Prior to approval, an on-site inspection may be required by TVWD.
- The total rebate per item will not exceed the receipt amount.

Customers can take advantage of each rebate maximum one time per account.

How To Apply For A Rebate

- Complete the proper application form and return it with a copy of the proof of purchase receipt. Upon approval, your rebate will be processed within 4-6 weeks.

Residential Rebate Programs

Washing Machine Rebate

- ◆ A typical household does nearly 400 loads of laundry per year, using about 40 gallons of water for a full load with a conventional washer. A full-size ENERGY STAR™ qualified washer uses around 15 - 20 gallons per load.
- ◆ Save 25% in drying time electricity costs, and eliminate the wait between when your washing machine and dryer are done!

Water efficient washing machines can save more than 7,000 gallons of water per year!

Apply for a **\$50 rebate** when you purchase and install an Energy Star qualified clothes washer.

Toilet Rebate

- ◆ Toilets are typically the largest indoor water user. Older toilets use between 3.5 and 7 gallons per flush (gpf) while high-efficiency toilets (HETs) and dual flush toilets use 1.3 gpf or less. This is more than 50% to 75% savings in water per toilet!

With a high-efficiency toilet, a household can save up to 16,000 gallons of water per toilet per year!

Apply for a **\$75 HET Rebate (for an EPA WaterSense labeled toilet)** when you replace a toilet with a new toilet that uses 1.3 gpf or less.

Limit of three toilet rebates per household.



Weather-Based Irrigation Rebate

- ◆ New technologies can cut water use by 25% or more while maintaining the health and beauty of your landscape.

Receive up to a **\$200 rebate** to install a weather-based irrigation device:

- Evapotranspiration (ET) controller **OR**
- Soil moisture sensor

Contact TVWD's Water Conservation Department at (503) 848-3056 or conservation@tvwd.org to make sure your device(s) qualify for the rebate and funds are still available.

Note: New and upgraded devices must be inspected and verified by a licensed landscape irrigation contractor. The inspector's signature on the rebate application form is required. If you plan on installing the device yourself, contact TVWD for rebate approval. A partial list of qualifying irrigation devices can be found at www.tvwd.org or by calling (503) 848-3056.

How To Apply

1. Install equipment according to manufacturer's specifications.
2. Visit www.tvwd.org or contact TVWD at (503) 848-3056 or conservation@tvwd.org for a rebate application form.
3. Mail all paperwork, including the completed original application and a copy of a sales receipt or purchase invoice from the retailer that specifies the date purchased, product, manufacturer and model number to TVWD.
4. The completed form and receipts must be received by TVWD within 90 days of purchase date.
