



Standard Response Protocol is a uniform, planned, and practiced response to help keep communities safe. The I Love You Guys Foundation created the protocol for consistent, clear, shared language and actions that can be applied in any emergency. It has been adopted by businesses, schools and government agencies and consists of five specific actions that can be performed during an incident:



HOLD

Hold is used when hallways need to be kept clear of occupants.



SECURE

Secure is used to safeguard people within a building.



LOCKDOWN

Lockdown is used to secure rooms and keep occupants quiet and in place.



EVACUATE

Evacuate is used to move people from one location to a different location.



SHELTER

Shelter is used to communicate safety information for self-protection.
