



Power outages can have significant impacts on our daily activities, including lighting, heating/cooling, food preparation and storage, and medical equipment. Plan now to be ready.



## Before an outage:

- Prepare an outage kit that contains flashlights, portable chargers, a hand or battery-powered radio, extra blankets, and emergency food, pet food, water, and first aid supplies.
- Know how to operate electric garage doors manually.
- Use surge protection equipment.
- Create a plan for electric medical devices and refrigerated medicines.
- Sign up for alert systems and apps for text alerts.



## **During an outage:**

- Keep freezers and refrigerators closed.
- Only use gas or camping stoves outdoors in well ventilated areas.
- Use generators outdoors and away from windows.
- Disconnect appliances and electronics to avoid damage from electrical surges.
- Use flashlights, not candles.
- Have a deck of cards, board games, or books to keep busy.



## After an outage:

- Call 911 if you see a downed power line and stay away from it.
- Don't go into flooded areas or use electrical equipment that may have been submerged.
- Throw out food in your refrigerator or freezer that has been warmer than 40 degrees.
- Restock used items from your outage kit.
- If you have electrical issues, contact an electrician.
