

During an emergency, officials need to be able to deliver quick, accurate information about what you can do to minimize impacts to your health and safety. In addition, it is critical that others can reach your emergency contacts if you are unable to do so. Take the following steps to ensure you and your loved ones receive the information needed to stay safe and healthy.



List *In Case of Emergency (ICE)* contact in your phone

ICE information contains important medical information and allows first responders to use your cell phone to reach people you want contacted in an accident or other emergency. Most smartphones come with a feature that allows you to enter ICE information that’s accessible from your phone’s lock screen.



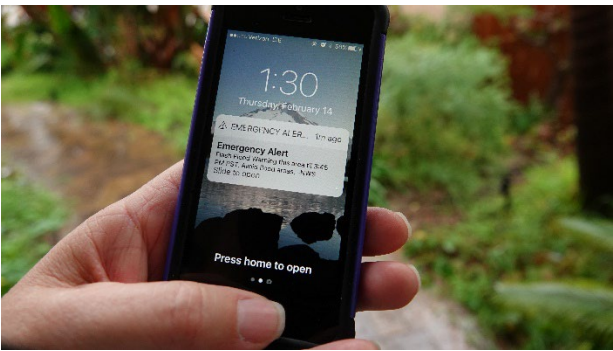
Add emergency contacts to online Oregon DMV tool

Drivers with Oregon licenses can add up to two emergency contacts in the DMV’s online system, allowing Oregon law enforcement to contact accident victims’ families if the driver is unable to do so. Only law enforcement has access to the emergency contacts. Sign up for the service at [DMV2U.Oregon.gov](https://dmv2u.oregon.gov).



Update your TVWD contact information

TVWD uses email and phone numbers to alert customers of emergencies with their water service, such as water shutdowns, boil water and do not use notices. Visit tvwd.org/UpdatePhone to update your contact information.



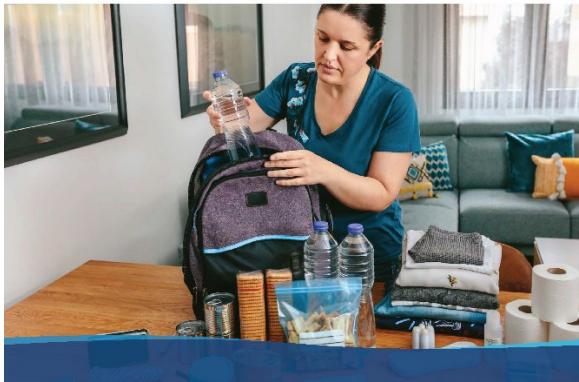
Download emergency notification apps for your phone or tablet
