Remember toilet paper and hand sanitizer!



"LOCKDOWN KIT" Bucket with Toilet Seat Lid
If your kit is on a budget, this item is a good start. If you use a bucket, a two-bucket system is recommended. One for liquid waste and one for solids. A method to compost solids is necessary with the bucket toilet.



GO Anywhere Portable Toilet (The PETT)
Folds up into a nice carrying case. Chemicals to treat waste are included.



GO Anywhere Toilet System
For the deluxe kit builder, this alternative is for you. It includes a backpack to store and tote all the gear.
